


Traditionally, progression looked like this...


Progression Code




Five principles of progression underpin progression across all Areas. The principles are....

- 3.1.2 Increasing effectiveness.
- 3.1.3 Increasing breadth and depth of knowledge.
- 3.1.4 Deepening understanding of the ideas and disciplines within the Areas matters.
- 3.1.5 Refinement and growing sophistication in the use and application of skills.
- 3.1.6 Making connections and transferring learning into new contexts.







We understand that measuring progress is complex, at Crynallt we look at the whole child and use a range of assessment strategies to ensure our pupils make effective progress across all areas of learning.



We draw upon a range of information to ensure every pupil is supported appropriately. We place huge value on the importance of "formative" and "in the moment" assessment which enables the staff to facilitate immediate progress. Parents receive regular information on their child's progress and are given help to understand their next steps in learning.
