Part A: Strategy Plan

Statement of Intent

Gobeithiwn y bydd ein cynllun strategaeth yn gweithio tuag at yr amcanion hyn drwy wella eu sgiliau llafaredd a darllen Cymraeg, sydd wedi'u nodi gan ein prosesau hunanarfarnu ac sy'n rhan o'n blaenoriaethau ysgol gyfan penodol o fewn y cynllun gwella ysgol ar gyfer 25-26. Anelwn at ddatblygu'r plentyn cyfan a chreu darpariaeth ddiogel a chynhwysol.

We are committed to ensuring that every member of our family receives the best education in a homely and safe environment. Every member of the family is encouraged to reach their full potential whatever their ability through providing challenging and extended opportunities in order that he or she can become an independent learner in a bilingual society. by developing their integral and thinking skills.

We hope that our strategy plan will work towards these objectives by improving their Welsh oracy and reading skills, which have been identified by our self-evaluation processes and are part of our specific whole school priorities within the school improvement plan for 25-26. We aim to develop the whole child and to create a safe and inclusive provision.

Part B: Review of outcomes in the previous academic year

PDG outcomes

Gwnaeth gwariant y GDD y llynedd i'r ysgol barhau â gwariant cymorth tuag at wersi cerdd ychwanegol ar gyfer 7 disgybl, darparu cymorth i 12 o ddisgyblion fynychu ymweliadau preswyl trwy gydol y flwyddyn.

- Mae bron 25 o rieni newydd yn cwrdd yn wythnosol yn yr ysgol.
- Mae bron 12 rhiant yn mynychu sesiwn Aros a Chwarae.
- Mae bron 8 rhiant wedi ymgymryd mewn sesiwn coginio gyda'u plant.
- Mae 4 rhiant wedi mynychu cwrs Cymraeg a Rhifedd gyda'r ysgol.
- Gwnaeth yr ysgol cynnal sesiwn 8 wythnos Tyllino babi.
- Derbyniodd 34 o ddisgyblion gefnogaeth ychwanegol yn llwyddiannus mewn Llythrennedd a rhifedd gan 2 gymhorthydd dosbarth.
- Derbyniodd 3 o gynorthwyr dosbarth amrywiol hyfforddiant i gyflwyno o fewn a thu allan i'r ystafell ddosbarth.
- *The PDG spend last year enabled the school to continue support expenditure towards additional music lessons for 7 pupils, provide support for 12 pupils to attend residential visits throughout the year.*
- *Nearly 25 new parents attend the school weekly.*
- *Nearly 12 parents attended the school weekly with 'Stay and Play' prog*

- *Nearly 8 new parents attended the cooking session with their children*
- *4 new parents attended the Welsh Learner and Maths course in school*
- *The school offer a new 8 week block of baby massage*
- *34 pupils received additional support successfully in Literacy and numeracy by 2 classroom assistants.*
- *3 classroom assistants received various training to deliver within and out of the classroom.*
