Mathematical Development

This week we'll look at calculating change when paying for things with 10p Complete the file called 'Change from 10p' in your shared files on HWB.

First work out the amounts the coins make then calculate the change from 10p

Use your fingers to count and help you take

1 finger = 1p

away to find the change.

So if the coins make 8p take 8 fingers (8 fingers = 8p) away from 10 fingers (10 fingers = 10p) then count the fingers left to find the change. Then work out which coins to use to make the change.
