Mathematical Development

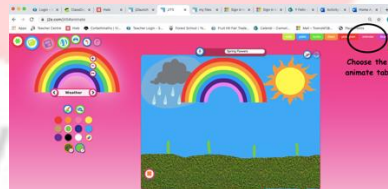
- *Look at the Powerpoint called Digital clock in your Hwb folder to learn about using a digital clock.
