## Attendance

Attending education is important for children and young people's development, health, and well-being. The long-term impact of missing education should not be underestimated. Children with mild symptoms can continue to attend their education setting. Mild symptoms include a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough, in children who are otherwise well. Children who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home. They can go back to their setting when they no longer have a high temperature and are well enough to attend. If your child has a stomach bug and has had sickness and/or diarrhoea, then they should stay at home until at least 48 hours after the last bout of sickness to prevent spreading infection. Please try and arrange holidays outside of term time.

**Any absences must be reported to the office on the first day of absence.**



## Labelling

Can we kindly ask that parents clearly label every item of school clothing for their child. We have a large lost property bin, full of unlabeled items. If clothing is labelled, we can successfully return it safely to the rightful owner. Diolch yn fawr!

## Medication

If your child is receiving medication, please could you administer any dosages before and after school. If it is necessary to administer further dosages, you are welcome to do so during school-time. Children who have a Medical Statement and/or who have a prescribed dosage of medicine will have their medicine administered by volunteers, however, you must complete a consent form and bring the medicine in the correct package, with the name and dosage clearly marked. Medicines should not be put in children's bags - please ensure you hand the medicine to a member of staff. Please note eye drops will not be administered by school staff.



**REMINDER:** Please **DO NOT** leave your child unattended whilst waiting for the Breakfast Club to open.



## Procedure for contacting staff

If you would like to discuss any issues with a member of staff, then the first step is to contact your child's teacher via Google classroom.
