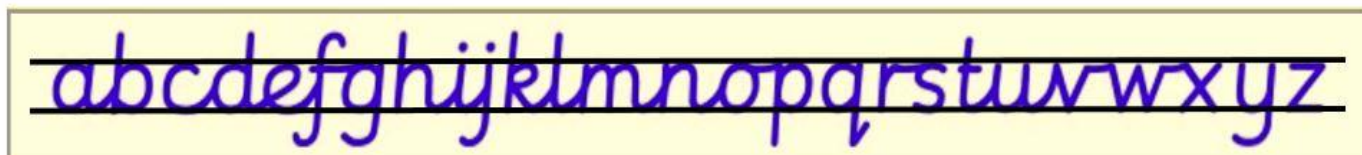
Snow – Excitement broke out across the school on Tuesday morning as the snow came down! Everyone ventured outside to enjoy the covering of snow across the playground!
