

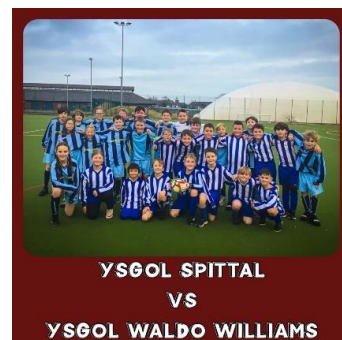


Spittal V.C. School
