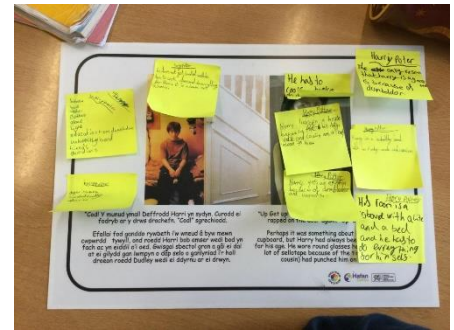


Spectrum Workshop for Year 1-6
