Balanceability in Reception and Camau Bach!

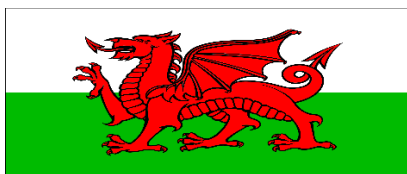
Children in Reception class and Camau Bach are having great fun developing their balance skills and early bike riding skills in weekly sessions with staff. What's more they are having great fun too!!
