

Will I see my friends?



You will see some of them. This is because we have to stick to the 2m rule so there are less places for everyone to be in school together. So, it will be approx. 4 children in the class pod.

Will I be in school every day?



At the moment, no. You will be school for 1 morning per week. (Year 6 will have 2 per week). This is because there is less space, and every child must have at least 3 sessions over the rest of the term. You will still be expected to complete your daily tasks at home.

Will I be with my teacher?



Yes. Your teachers are very much looking forward to seeing you and having a chance to 'check in' before the Summer holiday. Year 6 will have sessions with Mr Davies and with Mrs Bransden or Mrs Cook.

What about going to the toilet?



Only 1 person can be in the toilet at a time. We have given each pod(class) its own toilet. There will be no boys/girls toilets so you may be asked to use a different toilet to what you are used to. Your teacher will help you with this. You need to wash your hands well after going to the toilet.

Will we have playtime?



Yes, there will be breaks and plenty of opportunities for being outside. We have painted spots on the yard to help you keep 2m distance. You can create your own games with these!

Will we have dinner in school?



No – as you will be going home for lunch. If you are with Mrs Southam in the Hub Club in the hall then you will need a packed lunch that you will eat in the hall or if it's nice, you can eat outside.

Will we all use the same door?



No – each pod class will have their own entrance and exit. These have been shared with your grown up.

Will we have assembly?



We won't be able to have our assembly in the Hall because there will be a 'Hub Club' with Mrs Southam in there. We can have classroom assemblies and circle time. We will discuss what you have been doing and how you feel. Mrs Phillips will join in using video calls on the big screens in class too.

Will we all start and finish at the same time?



We will have different times to start and finish school. These times will be organised by families so your brothers or sisters will have the same times, so your mums and dads won't have to wait around on the yard. This is because of the rule 2m. These times will be shared via email.

Will we be safe in school?



We will do our utmost to make sure you are safe. You will need to continue to wash your hands often. You will have your own pens and pencils and you will need to keep to the 2m rule.

If anything worries you it will be important that you talk to an adult. Please wear sun cream to come to school if the weather is good and bring a hat.

Will people wear face masks?



No, I don't believe it will be necessary for the normal school routines. However, there will be masks at school for the adults if a child becomes unwell when they supervise them while we wait for their grown up to collect them.

Will I need to wear my school uniform?



At the moment- no. You can wear your own clothes. You will need to wear clean clothes every day. If you find your laces hard to do yourself, then ask your grown up if you have shoes without laces to wear.

You don't need a bag and do not bring toys. You will need to bring a large water bottle and a piece of fruit for breaktime. You need a waterproof coat and wellies too.

Will I be able to give my friends a cwttch/hug?



At the moment – it's better not to. It is important that we keep the 2m rule to keep safe. However, there are other ways to show your friend that you really like him or her! Why not raise a hand, throw a kiss, or maybe you can think of a more creative way to do it! We'll be able to give a cwttch or hug very soon.
