

Datganiad Grant Amddifadedd 2021-22 Ysgol Llannon

Dyrennir y Grant Amddifadedd Disgyblion i ysgolion â disgyblion sy'n dod o deuluoedd incwm isel ac y gwyddys eu bod ar hyn o bryd yn gymwys i dderbyn prydau ysgol am ddim (e-FSM) a disgyblion sydd wedi derbyn gofal yn barhaus am fwy na chwe mis (LAC).

Disgwylir i ysgolion ddefnyddio'r cyllid hwn i'r eithaf i gyflwyno strategaethau cynaliadwy fydd yn arwain yn gyflym at newidiadau i ddysgwyr sy'n gymwys i dderbyn prydau ysgol am ddim neu sy'n LAC.

Fel ysgol rydym wedi cytuno ar y tri cham a ganlyn:

1. nodi'r grŵp targed o ddisgyblion, ei nodweddion a'i anghenion
2. cynllunio ymyrraethau sy'n gwneud y defnydd mwyaf effeithiol o adnoddau
3. monitro a gwerthuso effaith adnoddau

Yn 2021-22 rhoddwyd i Ysgol Llannon ddyraniad Grant Amddifadedd disgyblion o £4, 600.

Yn Ysgol Llannon mae gennym gynllun cynhwysfawr, sydd wedi'i gytuno a'i fonitro gan Awdurdod Lleol Sir Gaerfyrddin, i hyrwyddo cynnydd a chael gwared ar rwystrau i ddysgu i fyfyrwyr sy'n gymwys ar gyfer y cyllid hwn.

Rydym wedi defnyddio'r cyllid sydd ar gael i:

- gyflogi staff sydd yn gweithredu rhaglenni ymyrraeth penodol a fydd yn codi safonau cyrhaeddiad y disgyblion
- darparu rhaglenni ymyrraeth a chymorth y profwyd eu bod yn cael yr effaith fwyaf a'u bod yn gynaliadwy- ELSA, 'Chwarae Cadarnhaol', 'CHATT',
- brynu adnoddau addas i gefnogi y disgyblion.
- Gyflwyno ymarferion adferol o fewn yr ysgol er mwyn datblygu perthnasoedd positif i wella ymddygiad
- Gostyngiad i deuluoedd PYD i fynd ar gyrsiau preswyl.

PUPIL DEVELOPMENT GRANT –STATEMENT YSGOL LLANNON SCHOOL 2021-2

The Pupil Development Grant (PDG) is allocated to schools with pupils who come from low-income families and are currently known to be eligible for free school meals (e-FSM) and pupils who have been looked after continuously for more than six months (LAC).

Schools are expected to make the best use of this funding to implement sustainable strategies that will quickly bring about changes for learners eligible for free school meals or who are LAC.

As a school we have agreed the following:

1. to identify the target group of pupils - characteristics and needs
2. to Implement provision to ensure higher levels of achievement
3. to monitor and evaluate progress

In 2020/21 Ysgol Llannon was provided with a PDG allocation of £4,600.

At Ysgol Llannon we have a comprehensive plan, agreed and monitored by Carmarthenshire Local Authority and ERW, to promote progress and remove barriers to learning for students eligible for this funding.

We have used the funding available to:

- To employ staff to introduce programmes that will raise the standards of pupils
- To provide intervention and support programmes that are proven to have the greatest impact and to be sustainable- provide specific high quality training for school staff e.g. ELSA, Positive play, CHATT
- To purchase suitable resources to support pupils.
- To introduce restorative practices in school to develop positive relationships to improve behaviour
- To give families of FSM a discount to residential trips.
