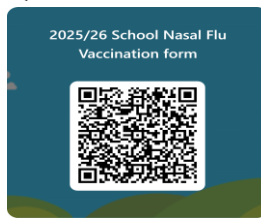

Dear Headteacher,

Re: National Influenza Immunisation Programme – Reception to year 6 pupils.

The Immunisation session date of 21.10.25 has already been agreed with you.

The School Nursing Service will be using the electronic consent form for the immunisation programme this year. Please find below the link to the electronic consent form and covering information letters for parents, in support of the National Influenza Immunisation Programme. Please can you share the date of the session and this link with parents at least 4 weeks prior to the session.

The School Nursing team will arrive between 8:30 - 9am on the morning of the session.

To encourage a safe session with minimal disruption to the school we request that an appropriate venue is made available to our team with consideration of the points outlined below:

- A large classroom/hall suitable with close access to hand washing facilities and a telephone
- Tables and chairs suitable for vaccine preparation and administration.
- Ground floor location if possible, to allow easy access.

We kindly ask that a member of the school staff be assigned to support the session by supervising children while they wait and assisting the nursing team with any enquiries. This staff member should



be familiar with the students and able to identify them to the vaccinating nurse for consent verification

Our administrative team will contact the school 24 hours before the session to confirm whether any vaccine-related concerns have arisen.

Following the session, the immunisation team will ensure all clinical waste is disposed of safely and will remain on-site for at least 20 minutes after the final immunisation has been administered.
