School Targets (from the questionnaires):

- Outdoors to be painted.
- School to be made more visible from the road.
- Develop extra curricular activities.
- Update school website.
- Electronic copies of the newsletters rather than paper copies.
- School app to report information.
- Consider homework format. Update homework policy.
- Termly parent input to what is being taught.
- Parent involvement in outdoor learning: gardening.
- Reinstate fruity Fridays and remind all parents of healthy option snacks for break times.
- Inform parents on next newsletter of the J2Blast rather than TT Rock stars.
- Parent / pupil open evenings.

School Targets (from the parent coffee mornings):

- Homework: weekly spelling / times tables / reading. Plus one additional activity per week. These to be from Friday to Friday to give parents time over weekends to complete these. Children not participating not to have their golden time taken from them. This to be linked with a 'show and tell' session every Friday where children explain what they have done and what they have learnt. Additional homework also to be consolidation of the week's work.
- TM to set up 'Friends of Tairgwaith School' initial meeting, rather than a more structured PTA. Fundraising events to be arranged from this meeting. School target wish list: cooking trolley? Etc.
- Parent / pupil open evenings to be arranged.
- Parents liked the fact that their children implemented their ideas into planning. Continue with Plan our term / week.
- TM to plan half termly Head teacher open surgeries for parents in order to discuss ideas and concerns.
- Continue with parent voice planning input.
