1. September

3. First Aid

Preparing for the new school year we wish to clarify procedures and protocols for dealing with First Aid.

- Parents will be contacted if it is **felt appropriate** and where there has been a head injury.
- An accident report will be completed if the injury is not a minor one.

Minor accidents are dealt with in the school, but **accidents of a more serious nature, needing medical attention are notified to the parents/ guardians.** Occasionally, an accident occurs when it becomes necessary to take a child to hospital. If parents cannot be contacted, a member of staff will accompany the child to hospital or call for an ambulance.

It is imperative that we have correct mobile phone or home telephone numbers. If the school rings you we will not leave a voice message unless necessary. In September, Mrs Jones will send out a contact sheet with all details we hold on your child. Please amend and return. If necessary we will contact in order, named people on your child's contact record.
