FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Any parents or carers that are in receipt of the following benefits are also entitled to other school grants:-

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you don't also get Working Tax Credit and your annual income is £16,190 or less before tax)
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax
 Credit
- Universal Credit your household earnings must be less than £7,400 a year after tax. This does not include any income from benefits.
