...set ourselves high standards and seek and enjoy challenge. ...are building up a body of knowledge and have the skills to connect and apply that knowledge in different contexts.


...question and enjoy solving problems.

...give of our energy and skills so that other people will benefit and we are ready to play a full part in life and work.




