



Year 6 News ~ Welcome back! We hope you all had a lovely Christmas and New Year. In Year 6, we have started our new topic Discovery - Turrets, Towers and Tunnels. We began by undertaking a reading comprehension to learn all about castles in Wales. We then worked in our Cooperative groups to complete the 'Boats' activity. We worked in our cooperative groups to read, retain and relay information. We discussed what information was useful, what part of the text did we find least effective and what information stood out and justified why. When relaying and summarising information to our cooperative group, we focused on



punctuation, presentation and layout. We were very lucky on Wednesday. We had a visit from Harriet Eaton, a local historian. She came in to talk to us about local castles in Wales. We learned a lot about the Norman invasion and its impact on our local area. In maths, we have been learning to find a fraction of a quantity. We have applied our understanding to solve reasoning problems. Our right of the month for January is Article

They worked in their cooperative groups to read information, which they had to remember and record on their group worksheet. The groups needed to remember to use the correct punctuation and spelling and they enjoined being punctuation and spelling police officers and checking other groups work. Many facts were recorded in this fun activity and it broadened the children's knowledge of Forces. Great work carried out by all groups today.

We have also started our new topic Towers, Tunnels and Turrets



where we will be learning all about castles. We have discussed as a class what we know about castles and we have decided we would like to know why castles were built and what life was like in a castle. We have worked in cooperative groups to learn about different aspects of castle life and have also discussed why they were built. We then shared the information we learned with the other children in our group. We have been working really hard to learn the song 'Sing' by Gary Barlow and The Military

Wives Choir in readiness to perform for special visitors we have coming to school in the near future.

<u>Year 4 News ~</u> Year 4 pupils have had a busy start to the term! We are enjoying learning about our new topic Turrets, Tunnels and Towers, we



will be focusing on castles. Our class have taken part in a session with Heritage Education Officer, Harriet Eaton. Pupils learnt about different types of castles and their defences. We learnt about local castles in our cynefin of Baglan such as Plas Baglan which was a Norman castle and Neath castle. We have been





working in our cooperative learning groups to complete a reading boat activity. One by one we read information on castles in our cynefin and went back to our groups to share what we learnt. We then presented our findings. In maths we are revisiting work on the four operations. We are looking forward to continuing sessions with Premier League Primary Stars for PE.
