- ✓ Scouts, Guides, cadets, dance, etc.



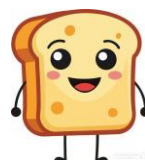

Breakfast Club

Doors open at 8.10am. Children **must not** arrive any later than 8.25am. Please ensure your children are always supervised for their own safety when waiting for the doors to open.

Breakfast Club is run by the 'School Meals Service' and any issues should be reported to that Service at Neath Port Talbot CBC and not the school.

Family Engagement Officer

We warmly welcome Ceri-Marie Jones, our new Family Engagement Officer. She will be with us every Monday and Wednesday, greeting families at the school gates and offering support, activities and experiences.

Attendance

Our target attendance is **95%**. Current attendance is **93%**.

- 95% = up to 10 days absent over a year (school target)
- Below 91% = more than 3 weeks' absence, which significantly impacts learning.

Lateness will also affect attendance. Being 30 minutes late daily = 2½ hours of lost learning each week.

Sickness If your child is unwell, please contact the school on the first day of absence.



➡ Unexplained absences will be followed up for safeguarding reasons.

Holiday requests can only be authorised if attendance is 95% or above, in line with Local Authority guidance.
