School Context

Betws Primary School is a small school serving a mixed socio-economic community. Approximately 34% of pupils are eligible for free school meals (eFSM). We are committed to ensuring equity of opportunity and closing the attainment gap for disadvantaged learners.

We aim to use our PDG allocation to:

- Improve outcomes for eFSM learners.
- Enhance wellbeing and engagement.
- Strengthen family and community partnerships.

Intended Outcomes

- Raise literacy and numeracy standards for eFSM pupils.
- Improve attendance and reduce exclusions.
- Increase parental involvement in learning.

Activities Funded by PDG

Targeted Literacy & Numeracy Support

- Employing a full-time and part time intervention teaching assistant to deliver small-group catch-up sessions.
- Purchasing evidence-based resources (e.g. Numicon, Read Write Inc, Tric a Chlic).

Wellbeing and Engagement

- Providing access to outdoor learning and enrichment activities.

Family and Community Engagement

- Offering support through TAF, Tim Camau Bach

Professional Development



- Staff training on trauma-informed practice and inclusive teaching strategies.

Monitoring and Evaluation

- Progress tracked through pupil assessments and wellbeing surveys.
- Termly reviews with SLT and governors.
- Feedback from parents and pupils used to refine provision.
