Trosglwyddodd 51 disgybl i ysgolion uwchradd ym mis Gorffennaf: 15 i Ysgol Bro Myrddin, 34 i Ysgol Dyffryn Taf a 2 i Ysgol y Frenhines Elizabeth. Mae 22 disgybl meithrin wedi cofrestri i ddechrau yn yr ysgol ym mis Medi 2022.

51 pupils transferred to secondary schools in July: 15 to Bro Myrddin, 34 to Dyffryn Tâf and 2 to Queen Elizabeth High School.
 22 new pupils have registered for the nursery class at the school for September 2022.



Cynllun Datblygu Ysgol (CDY)

Mae'r CDY yn gosod sail i fentrau'r ysgol ac yn anelu at wella meysydd penodol. Yn ystod y flwyddyn ddiwethaf blaenorriaethwyd yr ardaloedd canlynol:

Gosod Targedau

Mae'r ysgol yn parhau i ymgymryd â gofynion gosod targedau. Mae'r disgyblion yn cael eu tracio a gwneir pob ymdrech i gyrraedd targedau unigolion.

Mae'r Adroddiadau Blynnyddol i rieni yn nodi'r meysydd lle mae angen gwelliant, yn ogystal â Phroffil Un Tudalen ar gyfer pob dysgwr.

Lwfans y Pen

£20 y disgybl oedd lwfans y pen. Mae'r Gymdeithas Rieni unwaith eto wedi cytuno byddant yn cyfrannu i'r gronfa i alluogi adnoddau digonal ym mhob maes o'r cwricwlwm.

Diogelwch Ysgol

Adolygir y systemau diogelwch yn rheolaidd gan Staff Uwch yr ysgol a Rheolwr y Safle. Arolygwyd Diogelu o fewn yr ysgol gan yr Awdurdod Lleol ac Estyn yn 2020 a nodwyd bod systemau Diogelu yn gryf.

Iaith

Yn unol â Pholisi Iaith Awdurdod Addysg Sir Gaerfyrddin mae Ysgol Griffith Jones wedi ei chlustnodi yn ysgol ddwy ffrwd yn darparu ar gyfer plant Meithrin, Babanod ac Iau o 3-11 oed.

Ffrwd Gymraeg - Dosbarthiadau yn derbyn eu haddysg drwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg.

Ffrwd Saesneg - Dosbarthiadau yn derbyn eu haddysg yn bennaf trwy gyfrwng Saesneg a Chymraeg yn cael ei ddysgu fel ail iaith.

Cymraeg yw'r prif gyfrwng addysgu yn y Dosbarthiadau Meithrin, Derbyn a Blwyddyn 1. O Flwyddyn 2 ymlaen mae rhieni yn dewis naill ai addysg yn y Ffrwd Gymraeg neu'r Ffrwd Saesneg.

Target Setting

The school continues to meet its target setting requirements. All pupils are tracked to ensure that every effort is made to attain individual objectives.

Annual Reports to parents identify areas of improvement, as well as One Page Profiles for each learner.

Capitation

The capitation allowance was £20 per pupil. The PTFA have agreed that they will supplement this sum to enable all curricular areas to be adequately resourced.

School Security

School security is reviewed by Senior Staff and Site Manager continuously.

The Local Authority and Estyn have inspected Safeguarding within the school in 2020 and systems were found to be strong.

Language

In accordance with Carmarthenshire Education Authority's Language Policy, Ysgol Griffith Jones has been designated a dual stream school catering for Nursery, Infants and Junior pupils of the age range 3-11 years old.

Welsh Stream - Classes are taught through the medium of Welsh.

English Stream - Classes are taught mainly through the medium of English with Welsh taught as a second language.

The school Nursery, Reception and Year 1 Classes have Welsh as the main medium of instruction. From Year 2 onwards parents are given the choice of Welsh Stream or English Stream education.

Mae'r Awdurdod Lleol wedi cynnal ymgynghoriad i Bolisi iaith yr ysgol. Bydd y dewis o ffrwd Saesneg yn newid i flwyddyn 3 ym Medi 2022

This will change to Year 3 in September 2022, following a consultation of the Language Policy in the Foundation Phase by the Local Authority

Anghenion Addysgol Ychwanegol (AAY)

Mae'r system ar gyfer cefnogi plant a phobl ifanc ag anghenion addysgol arbennig ac anabledd yng Nghymru yn newid. Mae Llywodraeth Cymru yn cyflwyno system fwy hyblyg ac ymatebol o ddiwallu anghenion plant a phobl ifanc ag anghenion addysgol arbennig neu anableddau ac mae'n ymdrechu i ddarparu system addysg gwbl gynhwysol ar gyfer dysgwyr Cymru. Mae'r ysgol yn gweithredu'r gofynion newydd.

Ar hyn o bryd mae 85 o ddisgyblion yn cael cymorth, naill ai ar ffurf Darpariaeth Dysgu Cyffredinol neu Ddarpariaeth Dysgu Ychwanegol.

Disgyblion Anabl

Mae gan yr ysgol nifer fechan o ddisgyblion ag anabledd amrywiol. Mae'r disgyblion yma wedi eu hintegreiddio'n llwyddiannus i'r brif-ffrwd ac mae'r Awdurdod Lleol yn sicrhau bod adnoddau digonol mewn lle i'w darparu â chyfleoedd cyfartal.

Gwnaed archwiliad o ddarpariaeth yr ysgol ar gyfer disgyblion ag anabledd a ffurfiwyd Cynllun Hygyrchedd a'i weithredu.

Prospectus

The Prospectus has been reviewed. The document is now available on our website.

Additional Learning Needs (ALN)

The system for supporting children and young people with special educational needs and disability in Wales is changing. The Welsh Government is bringing in a more flexible and responsive system of meeting the needs of children and young people with special educational needs or disabilities and is striving to deliver a fully inclusive education system for learners. The school is implementing the new requirements. There are currently 85 pupils receiving support, either in the form of Universal Learning Provision or Additional Learning Provision.

Disabled Pupils

The school has a small number of pupils with different disabilities. The pupils are integrated successfully into mainstream and the Local Education Authority ensures adequate resources are in place to provide them with equal opportunities. An audit of the school's provision for disabled pupils has been carried out and an Accessibility Plan formulated and implemented.

Cyfleusterau Toiledau

Mae toiledau penodol ar gael i ddisgyblion mewn adrannau gwahanol yr ysgol. Yn yr adran dan 5 mae toiledau cymysg, toiledau i fechgyn a merched i ddisgyblion Blynnyddoedd 3 a 4 a thoiledau ar gyfer bechgyn a merched Blynnyddoedd 5 a 6. Mae yna 2 toiled ar gyfer plant ag anabledd.

Toilet Facilities

There are specific toilets for the under 5's within their classes. Pupils in years 1 and Reception have separate toilets near the main entrance. Pupils in years 3 and 4 have toilets in the main corridor, whilst pupils in years 5 and 6 have their own facilities outside their classes. There are 2 disabled toilets.

Curriculum and Assessment

Emphasis is placed on learning the basic skills of literacy and numeracy and the importance of making them relevant and meaningful to the
