Termly overview:

This term has a History focus that looks at the theme of governance and ways that decisions are made in Wales and compare with other places. We will also choose some key times in Welsh and periods of history from the learners' choice that involve governance and conflict. Our theatre trip touches on a famous explorer and how this developed understanding of classifications. We will make meaningful links between Humanities, Expressive Arts and other AOLE's that contribute to this and communicate what they have learned.
