- Up to £10 spending money




What not to bring

Sleeping and eating

- All children sleep in centrally heated bedrooms.
- They have to keep their rooms tidy!
- Staff stay in rooms on the same corridor as the children.
- Corridor lights are on through the night. Pillows are provided.
- 'Wobbles' at bedtime are normal. We'll get the children through them.
- Up to 4 meals a day (breakfast, lunch, tea and a snack).
- If there are food allergies or medically diagnosed dietary requirements (not general likes or dislikes), let us know and we'll inform the centre.

Cost and help with meeting them

- £180 per pupil including transport to and from the Centre, food, accommodation and all activities
- Payment plans can be put in place for pupils to attend
- Payments must be made in full by parents/carers

Schools Essential Grant for 2025/26

- Pupils must be eligible for means-tested Free School Meals (eFSM).
- Pupils who receive free school meals due to transitional protection arrangements do not qualify.
- All children in local authority care qualify for the grant.
