

Dear Parents/Carers,

The children have been taking part in many trips and activities over the last few weeks with Year 5 and 6 going to the Llanelli Wetlands and Year 4 going to Llangrannog. I'm sure that Mrs. Harvey and Ms. Brockelbank's class are looking forward to going to the Swansea Community Farm on Friday too. We've also had lots of sports events for our older children with boys, girls and mixed football competitions taking place for Years 3 to 6.

On the theme of being active, you may have noticed that our School Council been able to install two new sets of goal and basketball posts into the yards. The boys and girls have decided that one pitch will be a 'competitive pitch' with the other one being a more social, friendly sports pitch. We're having increasing difficulties with these in school, even though the phones are being used at home.
