Attendance

At Stepaside it is our priority that children are in school every day in order to grow and learn. Research clearly shows that when pupils miss school, it has negative effects on their well-being and education.

Attending school each day helps pupils to;

- Keep learning and developing new skills
- Has a positive impact on their mental health
- Helps develop their social skills
- Improves resillience, health and well-being.

Our attendance for the last academic year was 90.41%. This is significantly lower than our target of 95% and of other schools in pembrokeshire. I will be sending out information which explains attendance in more detail.

<u>Please note that for pupils with low attendance, this will</u> <u>automatically trigger intervention from the Education Welfare</u> <u>Officer.</u>

Seesaw

To make using the App easier, we will try and streamline the way we use Seesaw. Whole school messages will be sent in one conversation thread and newsletters will be sent in a separate thread – this way you can find important information and dates more easily. It might help to tidy up messages by hiding old conversations. You can do this by pressing and holding on a conversation until "*Hide message thread*" appears. Select this option and the message will disappear. If you have any questions or problems with Seesaw, please come and ask at the office where Mrs Williams or I will be able to help.
