Year 5 - Miss Gardiner

We've had a lovely fortnight in Year 5 since returning after our half term break. In maths, we have been recapping our multiplication and division skills - really building our confidence in these areas. In literacy, we have planned and written our own diary entries - constantly editing and redrafting to produce our best efforts. In topic, we have starting constructing our own balloon car to learn more about how things work. We are excited to be 'in charge' of our Red Dragon Shop next week, can't wait to see you there!

Year 1/2: Miss Evans We have had a brilliant start to our final term in Year 1/2. We have been learning how to tell the time, beginning with analogue clocks. We have learned how to construct a clock, what each hand represents, how many minutes are between each number and how long it takes for the minute hand to go all around once. We have also been able to tell the time to o'clock, half past and even quarter past and quarter to. We have been working on digital times this week too. We have found this a little trickier and will keep working hard. We have been learning our new Pie Corbett story, 'Monkey See, Monkey Do'. We have added actions to aid our retelling of the story and have been able to draw a story map. In science, we have planned an investigation to find out the best growing conditions for a plant. We have chosen 4 different conditions to consider. Two have been placed on the windowsill, one with both sun and water, one with sun but no water, then two have been placed in the cupboard, one with water but no sun and one with no water and no sun. All children have made predictions as to which they think will be the best conditions, providing reasons for their choice. We can't wait to find out the results. We have taken part in two Neath Afan Gymnastics sessions so far and have been having great fun learning different techniques and skills to improve our balance and coordination. We have also written instructions, how to make a pirate hat making sure we included a title, bossy verbs and numbered steps. Year 3 : Mrs D'Angeli

We had a lovely few weeks in Year 3 and have been working super hard. In science we have been so clever writing up evaluations from our investigations. We made so many clever prediction and worked well in our groups. Mrs D'Angeli was so proud of our efforts. We have also been investigating different organs in the body, locating them and beginning to understand their different functions. In welsh we have been busy using the past tense and planning a 5 day healthy diary. We have worked so hard remembering different vocabulary and using past tense sentence patterns. In Maths we have been using the column method to subtract numbers. We have also been revising analogue times and getting to grips with digital time too. Our efforts have been amazing!
