IMPLEMENTATION

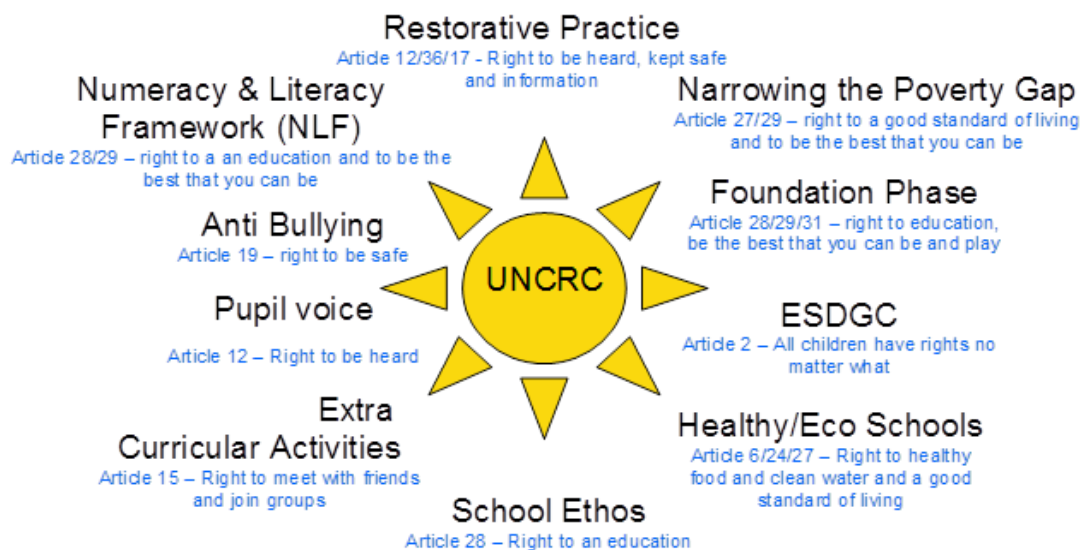
The County Borough Council is the Admissions Authority for Ynysfach Primary School as we are a maintained community school. All admissions are conducted in line with the regulations agreed annually.

Application forms are available from the School Admissions Section, Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council which the parent should complete and return to the Admissions Officer, Pupil Parent Support Section, Port Talbot Civic Centre, Port Talbot SA13 1PJ.

All the parents of pupils due to transfer from one sector to another at the end of the academic year will be sent and Admissions Application Form by the authority during the Autumn Term.

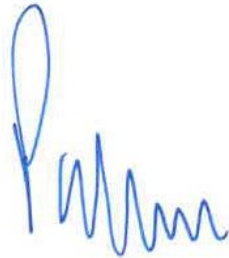
