Top Tips keep yourself safe outside School

- Talk to an adult you trust if you have any worries.
- Carry a mobile phone with you and have important numbers in your contacts.
- Do not accept anything of anyone you don't know.
- Never take a lift off a stranger.
- Stay in areas you know with your friends.
- Do not take any unnecessary risks when out and about.
- ❖ If someone is frightening you, try to draw attention to yourself and shout for help.
- * Never give personal details over the internet/social media.
- If someone contacts you through social media you don't know, tell an adult.
- If you receive unkind messages through text/social media tell an adult.
