



Skills Day: Monday, 2nd October, 2023

'Pop Star' is a themed day designed to develop a wide range of skills within the context of ICT, Art and Music. The tasks revolve around promoting a pop group. The day will consist of:

- Four 60 minute sessions within ICT, Art and Music Departments.
- Pupils to work within small groups.
- Work will be on display during Open Evening.

Session One-Music Video Part One

Using MovieMaker to create a music video.

Session Two—Music Video Part Two

Continuing work from Session One.

Session Three—Creating a radio jingle

Using recording software and microphones to create a radio advert/jingle to promote the group.

Session Four—Developing promotional materials

Create a poster to promote the group.

Conclusion

Pupils return to the Main Hall where the best music videos of the day will be shown.

Frequently asked questions about Skills Day:

- **What should we wear?** Your own school uniform, if there is one.
- What shall we do for dinner? You can bring a packed lunch or purchase a meal in the Canteen. £3.50 will be enough.
