Personalised Assessments Information for Parents from Year 2 to Year 6

We would like to inform you that your child has recently taken part in the National Personalised Assessments for Numeracy (Procedure and Reasoning) and Reading. These are statutory assessments that are taken by children across Wales from Year 2 upwards and are designed to support their learning by identifying strengths and areas for improvements.

The assessments are adaptive, meaning the questions adjust in difficulty depending on how your child responds.

From 4pm on Monday July 14th, you will be able to view your child's Personalised Assessment reports via their Hwb account. These reports are helpful in giving an indication of your child's progress at the time of the assessment. However, it is important to understand that these are one-off snapshots, taken on a specific day and do not reflect the full range of your child's abilities or progress they are making in class. Therefore, we kindly ask you to bare this in mind when viewing the reports.

Accessing the Assessments.

- Log in using your child's Hwb details
- Once logged on, navigate around the home page and click on 'Personalised Assessments'.
- Click on 'Learner feedback', where you can access the different reports.
