Part A: Strategy Plan

Statement of Intent

Mae hapusrwydd y plentyn yn allweddol i'w ddatblygiad ac yn ganolog i'n gweledigaeth. Wrth deithio drwy'r ysgol, anogir pob disgybl i wneud ei orau glas, cyrraedd ei botensial a llwyddo mewn cymdeithas ddwyieithog. Anelwn at sicrhau fod pob disgybl yn gwbl ddwyieithog, ac yn dangos cariad at wlad, iaith a threftadaeth.

- In line with the Local Authority and Welsh Government priorities, improve pupil attendance.*

Bydd disgyblion Blwyddyn 1 a 2 yn dilyn Rhaglen Aled Afal i gynllunio a datblygu sgiliau ysgrifennu Cymraeg.

<i>Ensure the development of pupils' literacy skills focusing mainly on reading (accuracy, fluency, understanding and enjoyment) and consistency in extended writing.</i> <u><i>Reading:</i></u> <i>It is necessary to continue to develop pupils' reading skills. 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<u>Writing:</u> Most pupils develop their writing skills effectively. It is necessary to ensure more opportunities to write independently and at length, effectively differentiating to ensure that all pupils are challenged.	<u>Writing</u> Nursery and Reception pupils will follow the Cadi a Tedi yn y Byd Bach Program which leads to the Aled Afal Program in Years 1 and 2. Year 1 and 2 pupils will follow the Aled Afal Program to plan and develop Welsh writing skills. Pupils in the Junior Department will complete weekly spelling tasks to help them write independently. Pupils will self-assess their work and assess the work of their peers against the success criteria. Pupils in the Junior Department will receive opportunities to re-draft their written work.

Mae angen sicrhau bod presenoldeb grwpiau o ddisgyblion e.e. y rhai sy'n gymwys i gael PYDd yn uchel. Mae angen targedu disgyblion penodol sy'n dangos patrymau o absenoldebau cyson sy'n achosi pryder. Bydd presenoldeb yn gwella o 94.5% i dros 95.5%. Bydd disgyblion sy'n achosi pryder yn dangos cynnydd yn eu cyflawniadau. Bydd disgyblion sy'n achosi pryder yn mabwysiadu agweddau llawer mwy cadarn at fynychu'r ysgol a'u dysgu eu hunain. <i>Processes for targeting absences will continue. Attendance will improve from 94.5% to over 95.5%.</i> <i>Pupils who cause concern will show progress in their achievements.</i>

<i>Attendance has improved from 92.6% (2023-2024) to 94.5% (2024-2025). However, attendance in a small school can change significantly if a few pupils were absent from school.</i> <i>It is necessary to ensure that the attendance of groups of pupils remains high e.g. those who qualify for FSM.</i> <i>It is necessary to target specific pupils who show patterns of frequent absences which cause concern. It is important that all pupils show a high level of attendance to have the best opportunity to progress academically and ensure healthy emotional well-being.</i>	<i>Pupils who cause concern will adopt much more robust attitudes towards attending school and their own learning.</i>

PDG outcomes

Defnyddiwyd Grant Datblygu Disgyblion y llynedd i ganiatáu i ddisgyblion fynychu ymweliadau ysgol oddi ar y safle ac ariannwyd disgyblion i fynychu cyrsiau preswyl yn Abernant (Canolbarth Cymru) a Pentre Ifan (Gorllewin Cymru). Roedd hefyd yn galluogi disgyblion i gael mynediad at ddarpariaeth gerddorol beripatetig.

Yn ogystal, roedd y cyllid yn ein galluogi i ryddhau staff i dderbyn hyfforddiant ar gyfer rhaglenni ymyrraeth penodol er mwyn cefnogi'r disgyblion yn eu tasgau dysgu.

This details the impact that our PDG activity had on pupils in the 2024 to 2025 academic year.

The Pupil Development Grant last year was used to allow pupils to attend off site school visits and funded pupils to attend residential courses in Abernant (Mid Wales) and Pentre Ifan (West Wales). It also enabled pupils to access peripatetic music provision.

In addition, the funding allowed us to release staff to receive training for specific intervention programmes to support pupils in their learning tasks.
