




In October, our KS2 pupils took part in **Restart a Heart Live**, where they learned the vital skill of CPR.

Harvest Coffee Morning


We would like to extend a heartfelt thank you to all the parents and families who attended our school Harvest Coffee Morning. We were truly blown away by the
