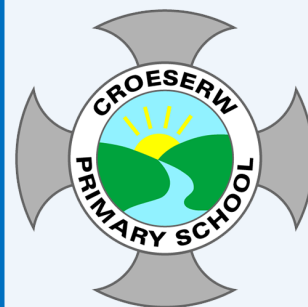

Medication:

If your child is required to take any medication that needs to be administered in school, including asthmas pumps, please complete a consent form at the school office. Thank you.



School times and Late Arrivals:

School starts at 8.50am and finishes at 3.00pm. Staff will be on the school yard from 8.40am to welcome the children into school and until 3.10pm at the end of the school day.

Nursery (AM) finishes school at 11.30am and Nursery (PM) starts school at 12.30pm.

If your child is absent from school, please ensure that you ring school on each day to provide a reason for absence so it is recorded on our register. If we do not receive a phone call, a text will be sent out, followed by a phone call from either Mrs Jones, Miss McErlean or Miss Ulberini.

Any pupils arriving late to school **must** come to the office to sign in. A record of late arrivals is kept in the office and monitored by the Education Welfare Officer (EWO).

All pupils must aim to maintain 95%+ attendance. Holidays are not authorised by the school and are monitored by the EWO.

School absence due to pupils not wanting to attend will be unauthorised and addressed by the Education Welfare Officer.

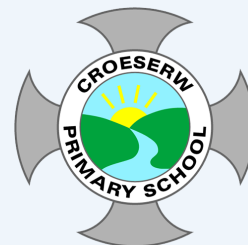
Daily Snack
