We need to:

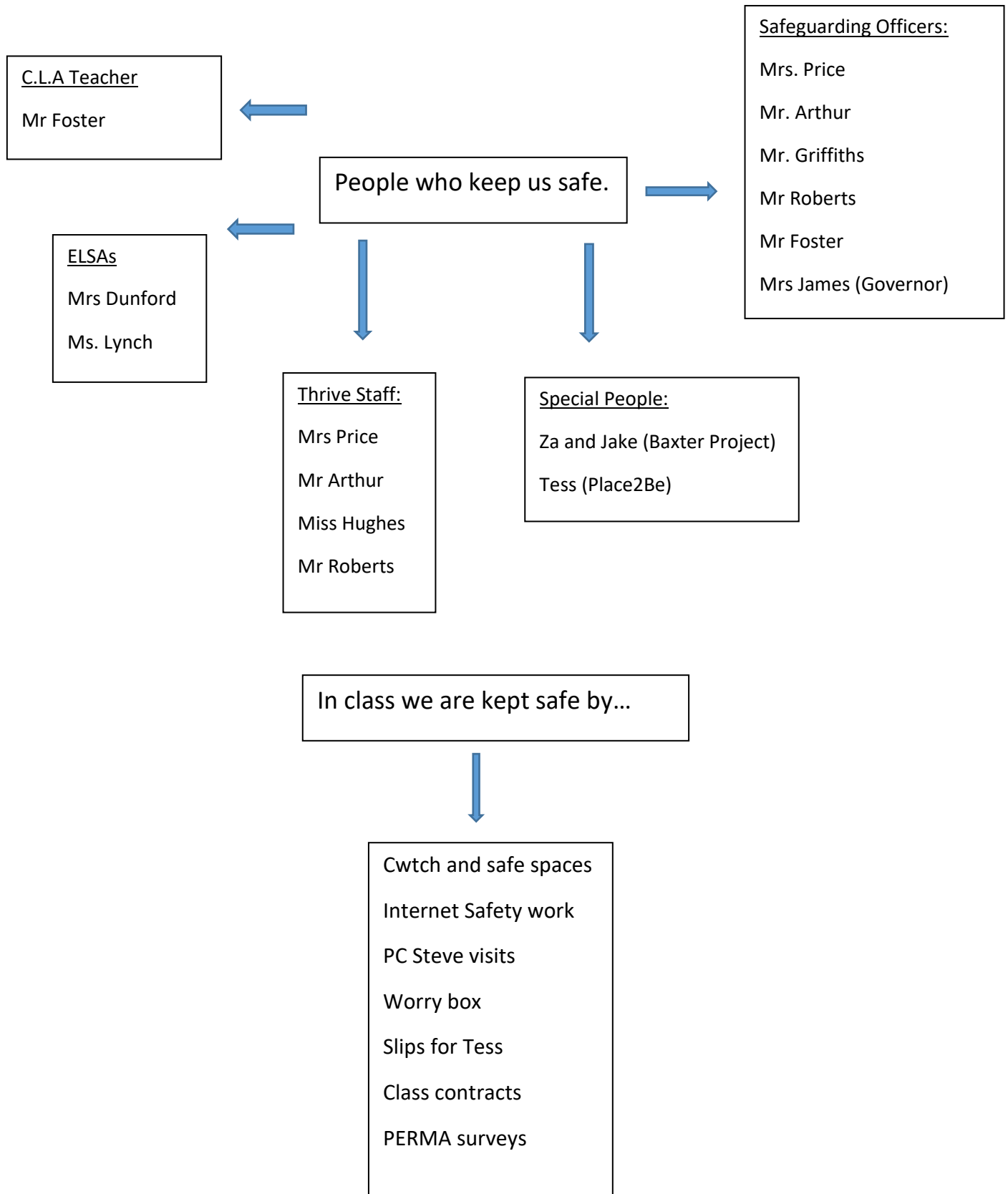
- Bring a water bottle to school and stay hydrated.
