



Years 1 & 2 - How can understanding bees and the changes they face, help us make a difference to protect them?



Should we change the way we live to help bees and the world they depend on?



Part 1

Why am I learning this?

I am learning this so I can begin to notice living things around me and understand that my actions can affect the world I share with others. I am learning that bees and other living things have needs and that people can help or harm their environment through everyday choices.

My learning experience

I will explore the school grounds and local environment to observe living things and where they live. I will ask questions, share my ideas and record what I notice using drawings, photos and talk. I will learn how to observe carefully and respectfully and begin to think about what living things need to survive.

How are bees and plants connected, and what do they give each other?



Part 2

Why am I learning this?

I am learning this so I can understand that living things depend on each other and that nothing lives completely on its own. I am learning that plants and bees help each other to survive and that these connections are important for the world around me.

My learning experience

I will observe flowers and insects and explore how bees collect pollen and help plants grow. Trip to I will take part in practical activities, role-play and creative work to show these connections. I will use simple counting and recording to notice patterns and share my understanding through pictures, talk and simple explanations.

What changes as living things grow, and how do we notice change over time?



Part 3

Why am I learning this?

I am learning this so I can understand that living things grow and change over time and that change does not happen all at once. I am learning to be patient, to notice carefully and to use evidence to explain what I see happening.

My learning experience

I will plant and care for plants and observe how they change over time. I will measure, count and record changes using simple charts, drawings and photos. I will compare what I notice at different times and talk about what has changed and what has stayed the same.

Is it fair if bees lose their homes because of humans?



Part 4

Why am I learning this?

I am learning this so I can think about fairness and understand that choices people make can affect other living things. I am learning to listen to different viewpoints and to explain my own ideas respectfully.

My learning experience

I will explore stories, drama and discussion about changes to habitats. I will think about how bees might feel if their homes are changed and what people could do differently. I will share my opinions, listen to others and begin to suggest ways to care for living things more fairly.

Part 5

Why am I learning this?

I am learning this so I can see that I can make a positive difference in my school and community. I am learning that working together, planning and trying ideas can help improve the world around me.

My learning experience

I will work with others to design and create a habitat to help bees, such as planting flowers or making a bee hotel. I will plan what we need, follow steps safely and work as part of a team. I will observe whether our actions make a difference and think about how we could improve them.

How can we share what we have learned so other people will care too?



Part 6

Why am I learning this?

I am learning this so I can communicate my ideas and help others understand why caring for living things is important. I am learning that sharing knowledge can encourage others to act responsibly.

My learning experience

I will prepare a way to share my learning, such as a performance, display, talk or guided tour. I will choose examples of my work to show what I have learned and explain why it matters. I will reflect on how my thinking has changed and what I can continue to do in the future.
