A commissioned report seeks approval from Cabinet to make changes to the Council's Sustainable Communities for Learning, band B and C Strategic Outline Programmes. The report requests the following - Removal of the Swansea Valley scheme from band B and replace with new build Godre'rgraig Primary school.

Their language journey has led to analysing and then creating a whole class instructional text!


