Home Learning Menu; 'Footprints'

Topic

Create a menu for a new dinosaur themed restaurant. Think about the appropriate vocabulary associated with the dinosaurs and try to be as imaginative and creative as you can. Remember to present your menu in a stylish and exciting way. Include clever names for the food and drinks, add prices and illustrations too. Your restaurant will also need a well thought up themed name and an eye-catching logo... I look forward to seeing your creativity and imaginative brains bringing to life the Brontosaurus Burgers and more!

Creative

Design and make a 3D model of a dinosaur using recycled materials from around your home. Your dinosaur can be based on the appearance of an actual dinosaur you have found out about, or it can be an imaginative 'new dino' with a look and name of your own making!

Science and Technology

Create a one minute video walking & talking us through something important from your World. This could be your bedroom set-up, your garden or any place in the local area you like being. You need to feature clearly in your video and you must talk us through what we are seeing and why it is important to you. This can be uploaded to the Google Classroom or saved in Office 365 on HWB.

Numeracy

Create a factsheet/ poster of numbers linked to the age of the dinosaurs. For example, you could research; the dates when specific dinosaurs were around and the names given to these eras, the tallest, the longest, the shortest, the heaviest or the lightest! Fill your page with fascinating number based facts and make it as eye-catching as possible with illustrations or pictures. This can be handmade or digital- be creative and try to be unique.

Please also remember there is **ALWAYS** weekly spellings and tables tests to practice. Reading should also be done as often as possible & listening to your own child read is not only enjoyable, but it is also proven to be very beneficial.
