



Here is the Home Learning for the Spring term 2024. Our topic is 'We'll meet again' which will see us learning about World War II.

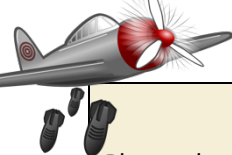

Home Learning Menu: We'll meet again



Literacy- Oracy	Topic
<p>Plan and prepare a 5-minute presentation to present to the class about anything that interests you. It could be based on animals, sports, hobbies, anything that you are interested in.</p> <p>You can use the computer to create and deliver your presentation, you can use pictures, add sounds, but <u>please make sure that you are only using short notes and prompts, please do not read from the script or the screen.</u></p> <p><i>*You will need to be ready by Monday 4th March*</i></p>	<p>Create a timeline of different events that occurred in WWII. Think about some of the major events, such as the bombing of Swansea, VE day etc. Mark them carefully on your timeline.</p>
Expressive Art	Expressive Arts /Health & Well-Being
<p>Make an air raid shelter/Anderson shelter, using materials you have around the house. Think about which materials would be best.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Research a WWII recipe and make it at home. You could bring it into school, or send us a picture or video instead.</p>	<p>Thinking about being evacuated, draw and explain what 6 things you would want to take with you if you were evacuated and write about why you chose them.</p>
Science and Technology	Numeracy
<p>During WWII morse code was used as a method of communication. Write a message in Morse Code and send it into school to see if your friends can decode it.</p> <p>Remember to write the message properly too, so your friends can check if they are right.</p>	<p>Complete the worksheet on Google Classroom, exploring Army rations. Use the pictures to explore if you are able to purchase all of the equipment needed for each platoon.</p>

Please also remember there is **ALWAYS** weekly spellings and times tables to practice.

Reading should also be done as often as possible & listening to your own child read is not only enjoyable, but it is also proven to be very beneficial.
