

## Termly Overview: Spring 2026

Catholic Virtues - This term we will be trying to be **Curious** and **Active, Intentional** and **Prophetic** learners.

Throughout the school day the children will hear and see the words and actions of the Sign of the Cross: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."

They will join in with our class and school prayers and begin to take part in services and celebrations in Mass.

### Galilee to Jerusalem

During this topic the children will;

- Know that the Wise Men visited Jesus and gave Jesus gifts.
- Know that Jesus welcomes everyone.
- Hear how Jesus fed 5000 people.
- Know that Jesus wants us to care for others, sharing what we can.
- Hear that 'Glory Be' is a special prayer.
- Know that Jesus is God's son and came for everyone.

### Desert to garden

During this topic the children will;

- Know that Lent is a time to care for others.
- Hear that Jesus died on a cross. It is a sad time. Jesus was given new life by God his Father.
- Hear that Jesus rose and everyone celebrates.
- Know that Easter celebrates new life.
- Recognise representations of Holy week and Easter.

### **Weekly Reminders**
