RE topics for this term:

Galilee to Jerusalem: During this unit we will:

- Retell the visit of the Magi
- Hear and retell parables
- Explore what the Kingdom of God is and what it is not.
- Explore how praying the 'Our Father' helps Christians to continue to build the Kingdom of God.

Desert to Garden: During this unit we will:

- Retell the story of the feeding of the five thousand.
- Describe how Jesus shows his love at the Last Supper and how he shares this love when people celebrate their first Eucharist.
- . Describe, with increasing detail and accuracy, the prayers, religious signs, and actions of the Mass, focusing on the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

Thursday: Our P.E. day. Please bring outdoor kit and suitable outdoor footwear.


Friday:

Activities will be sent home which link directly to what the children are learning in school and supports their work in class. Please make every effort to support them and to complete the tasks set.


