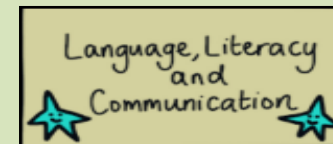


Competition - How do superheroes help each other?



Nursery

- Number songs & rhymes.

- Counting activities to 5.
- Match, order & compare.

Full time children

- Order and sequence time; First, next, finally. Days of the week. Months of the year.
- Build on number knowledge beyond 10.
- Number activities to 20; number bonds, odd & even, doubling.
- Addition & Subtraction.
- 2D & 3D shapes - patterns, properties & grouping.

- Clear and effective communication through role play areas
- Songs and rhymes
- Listening and memory games
- Retelling stories through actions and story maps
- Fine motor/gross motor activities
- Read Write Inc programme; word building and simple sentences.
- Letter formation
- Nursery pupils moving into Reception in September will begin the RWI programme this term, naming pictures and recognising initial sounds.
