During this topic the children will;

- Hear the story of Pentecost.

- Recognise that we are connected to each other. We can be different from each other, but we are still one family - God's family.

Dialogue and Encounter

During this topic the children will;

- Hear a simple life of St. Peter and St. Paul, friends of Jesus (linking to their feast day).
- Explore a range of pictures of Jesus from non-European tradition.
- Engage in opportunities to explore faith through music, clothing and food to enrich understanding.

Weekly Reminders
