RE topics for this term:

To the Ends of the Earth- By the end of this topic, pupils will have learnt about:

- Making links between scripture and the Mass
- Signs and symbols of the Holy Trinity
- Some of the prayers which express belief in the Holy Spirit and Holy Trinity.

Dialogue and Encounter- By the end of this topic, pupils will have learnt about:

- Some simple facts about how the Jewish festival of the Passover is celebrated by Jews in Britain today.
- Recognise links and simple connections between some Islamic religious laws, beliefs, worship, and life (e.g., belief in one God, the Creator, the significance of Muhammed, importance of the will of God etc.).

Thursday: Our P.E. day. Please bring outdoor kit and suitable outdoor footwear.

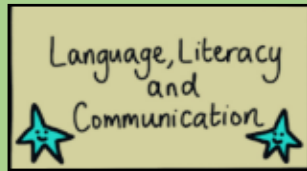
Friday:

Reading books and homework

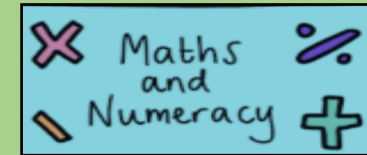
Regular reading and tables practise at home has a great impact on children's progress.
