Year 4 - Areas of Learning and Experience

Language, Literacy and Cammunication Inc: English, Welsh and ICT.

This term, Year 4 will be focusing on non-chronological report writing. In writing sessions pupils will continue to consolidate their accuracy in using spelling, punctuation and grammar. They will be encouraged to check and edit their written work with greater independence. Year 4 will be applying their language skills across all areas of the curriculum and will use ICT to enhance and present work. They will also experience the world of Minecraft education and begin to understand coding using lego wedo kits. They will be continuing to use Welsh on a daily basis through simple greetings and questions and will be taking part in regular welsh

Science and Technology

During Year 4's Science work this term, they will be encouraged to record observations along with ideas about what is happening and why. They will be investigating using scientific terminology to record accurately. This term our science focus will be 'states of matter'.

The children will also have opportunity to use and apply their Mathematical skills across the curriculum.
