SAFEGUARDING

What we do to keep us safe at Knighton Primary School

In our school:-

- We have adults that we can talk to about anything that might be worrying us- photos of the grown ups that work in school are on a board as you come into the school, by the office
- Mrs Rimmer is in charge of helping us all to be safe in school; she is the 'designated lead for safeguarding'. If Mrs Rimmer is not at school then Miss Jones and Mrs Fielding are in charge of helping us all to stay safe in school. We have a governor that is responsible for helping us keep safe in school, she is called Eirlys Spawton. When she comes into school sometimes she will tell us stories about when she and her sister were little!
- All of the staff at school go on training- they have training about fire safety, lifting things and using ladders, keeping us safe (Child Protection), making sure we are healthy and fit (well-being), on-line safety
- We have safe doors in school, and you need a fob to open them. The staff have special badges and fobs to open the doors
- We have new windows in school and they help to keep us safe as they have special glass in them and it means it is warmer in school too
- Any visitors to school need to wear a badge, so we know that they are visitors



What we do to keep safe outside

- We have fences around school to keep us safe and new fences are going to be put on the field soon- do not try to jump the fence or put anything on the fence
- On the field look out for anything that shouldn't be there and let an adult know if you find anything
- Don't litter on the field, car park or playground, always put your snack wrappers or fruit skins in the bin after you have eaten your snack. Pick up after yourself!
- Don't try to break or damage the playhouses on the playground, it will mean we can't use them as they won't be safe
- In the school car park make sure that cars are supervised at all times because people are crossing to go to the leisure centre or go in or out of school



FIRE SAFETY

- We have fire alarms in school to keep us safe and warn us if there is a fire anywhere
- We have special fire doors to help stop any fire from spreading
- We have special glass in our windows to help keep us safe
- We have practice fire drills so that we know what to do and where to go if there was a real fire at school
