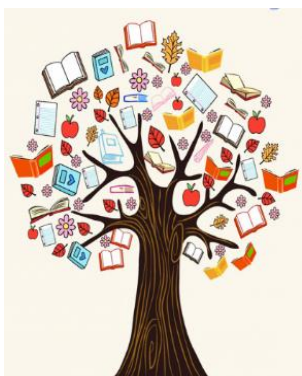

Make consistent use of 'SpellBlast' on Hwb. There will be weekly spellings added to it, thematic words and common misspellings.

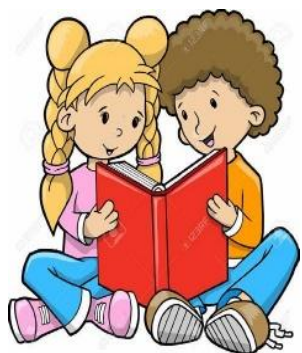
Numeracy

Reading Books



Try to ensure that your child reads something EVERY NIGHT. Welsh and English books will be changed throughout the week and your child will be reading at least twice a week so it's important they bring their books and their reading record to school every day. Children can change their books once they have finished and show an understanding of what they have read.



Physical Education
