

The aim of this page is to give you a taste of what goes on in the Year 2 classroom throughout the year.

The Foundation Phase is about enhancing the learning experiences which enable pupils to be creative, imaginative and to have fun whilst learning. Pupils will be given more opportunities to explore the world around them through implementing structured activities which will engage and motivate them to become effective learners.



### Homework – Spelling and J2Number blast

Spelling lists associated with the class work will be given every Wednesday. Make sure you bring the spelling books weekly to get a new list. The words are also changed weekly on Hwb (J2blast) to practice them. Pupils should also take advantage of the J2 Number blast app on their Hwb account to improve their multiplication skills.



### Reading books

We aim to read with the pupils every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday, therefore it is essential that they bring their books to school on these days. Books will be changed when the pupils have completed them and can show an understanding of what they have read.



### Muddy Wednesday

Every Wednesday afternoon pupils will take part in 'Muddy Wednesday'; all pupils are expected to change into their 'Muddy Wednesday' wear before taking part – these should be appropriate clothes and footwear for the weather and ones that can get dirty/wet and at times paint and other materials on.



### P.E and Swimming
