## New Waste Law - April 2024

You may be aware that from the 6<sup>th</sup> April, it became law for all businesses and public sector organisations to sort their waste for recycling. This has led to a reduction in general waste collections and an increase in recycling. If any children still bring packed lunches from home, they will now need to keep all of their waste from home in their lunchboxes to dispose of at home as the canteen is only disposing of food waste from school-provided meals. The children have been made aware of this change and we are using this as a learning opportunity for children to reduce their use of non-recyclable packaging.

### **Lettings Policy**

The Governing Body have been made aware of concerns in the local community regarding the use of the 3G pitch after school hours. It would appear that, despite the school's best efforts to enforce the terms and conditions of the hire agreement, there has still been numerous problems with unsafe parking. Therefore, we are undertaking an urgent review of the policy with a view to make amendments in preparation for the new academic year. We will keep you updated.

### **Attendance**

The Governing Body have set an attendance target this year of **94**% and current school attendance stands at **94.4**%. As we move into the Summer, a reminder that no holidays will be authorised in term time. Please try and arrange your holidays during the school holidays and aim for your child to be in school every day to keep their attendance high. This is proven to have a positive impact on children's wellbeing and progress in learning.

### <u>Uniform</u>

Uniform stays the same throughout the year, but the option of navy gingham summer dresses and navy shorts is added as the weather becomes warmer. Children should still wear sensible black shoes with their summer uniform - plain black trainers are permitted. Please do not allow your child to wear sandals, flip flops or Crocs to school as these are a health and safety risk when the children are playing. As the warmer weather approaches, please ensure your child has additional items - sunhats, suncream and water bottles in school. A lightweight coat is still recommended as we go into the summer months as it can still be chilly and wet outside.

In the event of extreme heat or sunshine, additional risk assessments are in place to limit the children's exposure to the sun. If we need to temporarily relax the uniform policy during very hot weather, we will send out a message to let you know.
