We welcome your reflections and queries prior to this meeting, and we will send a feedback form for you to complete ahead of your scheduled meeting. This will be sent electronically via an online form. Please complete this by noon on Monday 17th November. Staff will then be able to ensure that the reflection meetings are focussed and tailored to answering any specific queries that you may have on wellbeing and progress within the short time that is allocated.
