LRB Class Structure September 2026

As we have a high number of new pupils joining the LRB in September, we have finalised our LRB Class Structure earlier than usual to allow time across the Summer Term for enhanced transitions for pupils as they move into their new classes.

As you will see from the structure below, Miss Smith will no longer hold a class responsibility in the 2026/27 academic year and Mrs Corner will be moving into LRB1 as the new class teacher.

Mrs Corner has a wealth of experience in supporting children with Additional Learning Needs. She started with us as a Teaching Assistant in LRB1 in September 2019 and also worked in LRB2 before moving into a position as a Higher-Level Teaching Assistant, leading the Nursery class (she taught some of the current LRB children during this time). The school then supported Mrs Corner to undertake her PGCE qualification through the Open University and she qualified as a teacher in 2025 and has just successfully completed her Newly Qualified Teacher (NQT) Induction Year in one of our mainstream Year 1 classes. We are confident that she has the skills and experience to be a highly effective teacher in the Learning Resource Base.

Releasing Miss Smith from a class responsibility will then allow her more time to discharge her statutory responsibilities as the ALNCo. She will still teach classes within the school and will cover both LRB classes to allow statutory PPA release time for the LRB teachers, as well as working within Nursery to support the younger children identified with emerging ALN.
