Amendment to School Session Times

Thank you for your positive and respectful engagement in recent discussions around the Governing Body's proposal to implement a change to school session times.

The school followed the requirements of The Changing of School Session Times (Wales) Regulations 2009 and the following timeline of events is described below:

Date	Action
March 2026	The Headteacher and Governing Body identified the need to implement a change and consulted with the Local Education Authority and all other staff in the school.
13 th April 2026	A statement was prepared and shared with all parents of registered pupils, staff, stakeholders and interested parties.
13 th April – 27 th April 2026	Written comments and queries were received and formally logged.
28 th April	A meeting was held for all parents, staff, stakeholders and interested parties with comments and queries formally logged.
30 th April	The Governing Body met and considered all comments on the proposal and made a final decision to implement the changes without modification from 1 st September 2026
1 st May	The decision was communicated to the Local Authority, all parents, school staff, stakeholders and interested parties. (Via this letter)
